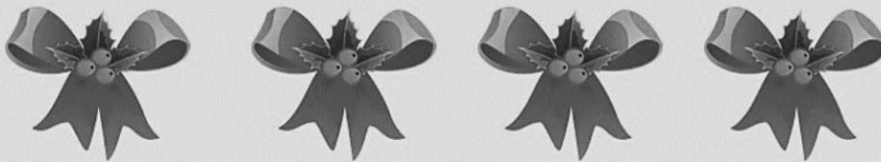


CHRISTIAN AID COLLECTION 2018
