On Sunday 20<sup>th</sup> May, the Bishop of Southwark will come to All Saints' to consecrate our new burial ground. The Bishop will preside at a service of Eucharist at 10am, not the usual 9.30am. Afterwards everyone will process to the new burial ground which the Bishop will consecrate. This means the land will be sacred and set apart for sacred uses. It is nearly 100 years since the last consecration of our land and it will be many, many years before the next.

On the day before the consecration, Saturday 19<sup>th</sup> May at 11am in the Vestry, everyone is invited to hear our Rector launch a new book, 'Stories from the Churchyard' which will be sold for £5 each to help the churchyard fund.

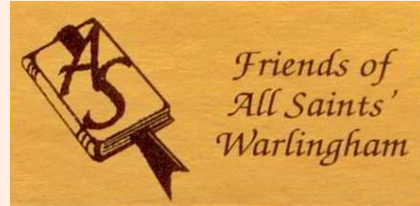
